## When does the celebration begin?

The celebration and performances will begin shortly before **6:00 pm EST**. At exactly 11:59pm EST, the Ball will make its 60-second descent down the flagpole to signal the start of the New Year. Revelers begin to gather in the afternoon.

#### Are tickets needed for this event?

**No** tickets are needed for the annual New Year's Eve in Times Square celebration, which is a free event open to everyone on a **first-come**, **first-serve basis**.

#### Where is the ADA reserved space?

The designated viewing area for individuals with disabilities is at 44th Street and Broadway, which is accessed at the southwest corner of 44th and 6th Ave. ASL interpreters will be present at this viewing area.

### Will there be portable public restrooms available?

There are **no portable restrooms** in Times Square during the celebration.

### What should I wear and what should I bring?

Dress warmly with layers and note that all bags will be searched. Items that are **NOT permitted:** Backpacks, Large bags, Umbrellas, Lawn chairs or other folding chairs, Picnic blankets, Large coolers, Alcohol
